Mr. Holt:

Included in this mailing is a copy of our internal investigation based on the complaint you have filed. Our investigation has not uncovered any misconduct by any employee of the Gainesville Police Department. The documents in question were printed by one of our department members and provided to the City Human Resources Department as allowed under FSS 119. A review of the documents that were mailed to individuals outside of the City revealed the police reports were copies of the same un-redacted report our department member provided the HR department. Additional documents that are not GPD documents were also included in the mailing. This suggests that the GPD documents in question were obtained from a source from city hall and not GPD or GPD members.

In reviewing the documents that were released, it appears there is a violation of FSS 119.10(2), if we can prove the violator knowingly violated provisions of FSS 119.071 regarding the release of confidential and exempt information. This would constitute a misdemeanor of the first degree. GPD does have the jurisdiction to investigate such a violation, however our investigation has not identified a possible suspect or source. If we were able to identify a suspect, we would have to prove they willfully and knowingly released the information in violation of FSS. Without a confession of such, this would be impossible to prove. If GPD receives information or evidence to identify a suspect in this case, we will continue our investigative efforts.
