**EXPEDITED SCHEDULING ORDER IN PRIORITY CASE**

This matter came before the undersigned at a Case Management Conference on May 11, 2020. Having reviewed the pleadings, the Court concludes that this is an elections case that is entitled to priority status and expedited disposition under Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.215(g). The Court therefore establishes the following deadlines and schedule:

All answers or motions to dismiss must be filed no later than May 15, 2020.

A hearing on any Motions to Dismiss will be held on May 26, 2020 beginning at 1:30 PM via teleconference. Two hours have been reserved. Dial-In information is as follows:

All motions for summary judgment must be filed and served no later than June 2, 2020. Responses to motions for summary judgment must be filed no later than June 16, 2020.

All discovery must be completed no later than June 16, 2020. No discovery after this date will be allowed except by order of the Court for good cause shown and upon a showing of due diligence.

This case is set for a final hearing on June 23, 2020 beginning at 1:30 PM. Two hours have been reserved. If any party asserts that genuine issues of material fact preclude summary judgment, the Court will determine whether to hold an evidentiary final hearing via video conference, otherwise the final hearing will be held via teleconference. 
